

Thank you to everyone who helped make it such a success.


Animal Blessing Service Sunday 6th October 2019 at 2pm in church.

Finance & Common Fund: discussion about talents, gifts and stewardship, appreciating all that people already give and exploring new ways of enabling people to support their church. Financial Management Policy and change of bank also agreed by the PCC.

Open House: plans to have display inviting contributions to our community consultation.

Parking: A significant and sustained increase in unauthorised parking has been noted with some drivers being increasingly unwilling to cooperate. The PCC passed a resolution agreeing to the purchase and installment of an electric bollard (St Paul's Way entrance) as this is deemed the most effective and least visually obstructive way of the church managing this issue.

Christmas Bazaar: Saturday 7th December 2019. We have a possible donor for 1st prize in the raffle.

Updates: Sunday School: important to encourage regular attendance for any child seeking to make their First Holy Communion next year.

Youth Group: Junior members are keen for the group to happen, but we need to recruit adult helpers. It is hoped that Youth Group will start meeting monthly after the mid term break.
